(Noun)

Evasion.

Tom was sentenced for having **eluded** the authorities about his financial dealings.

# Altruism

(noun)

Selfless concern for the welfare of others.


Here you go

# Ambivalent

(Adjective)

Having mixed feelings about something or someone.

# Conundrum

(Noun)

Faced with a problem which has no obvious solution.



Should I even try?  
Or not?

The thief faced a **conundrum**.

# Amenable

(Adjective)

Willing to agree to something that is asked for.



Ben was always **amenable** to whatever his father told him.

# Amorphous

(Adjective)


Shapeless and without any structure.



George's preparation for the test was **amorphous**.

# Analogous

When two comparable situations are looked at.



Ben's feelings about his new assignment were **analogous** to a fish out of water.
