teaching easy.

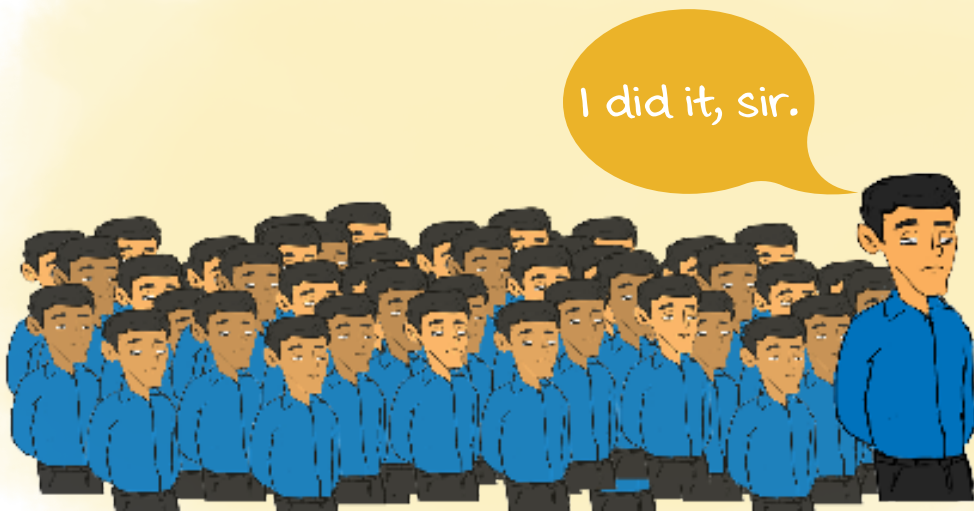


The students **espoused** David's teaching methods!

(Noun)

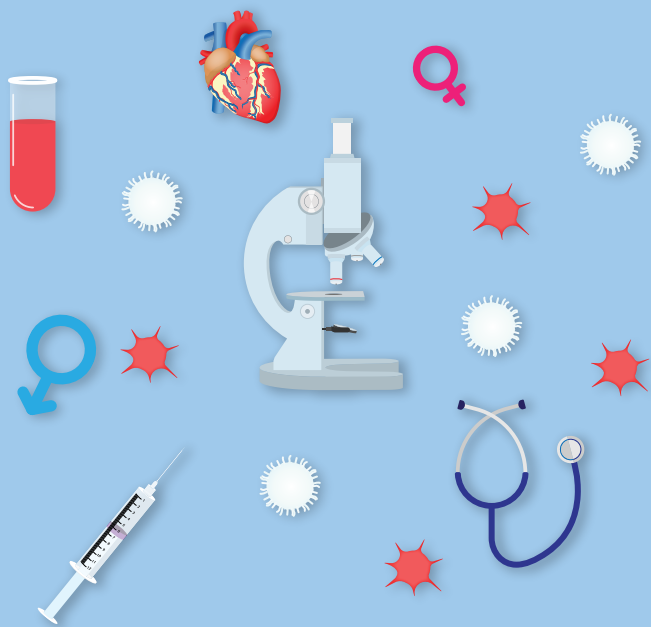
Foresight; to indicate the future.

Beliefs which are totally opposite to what most of the people believe.

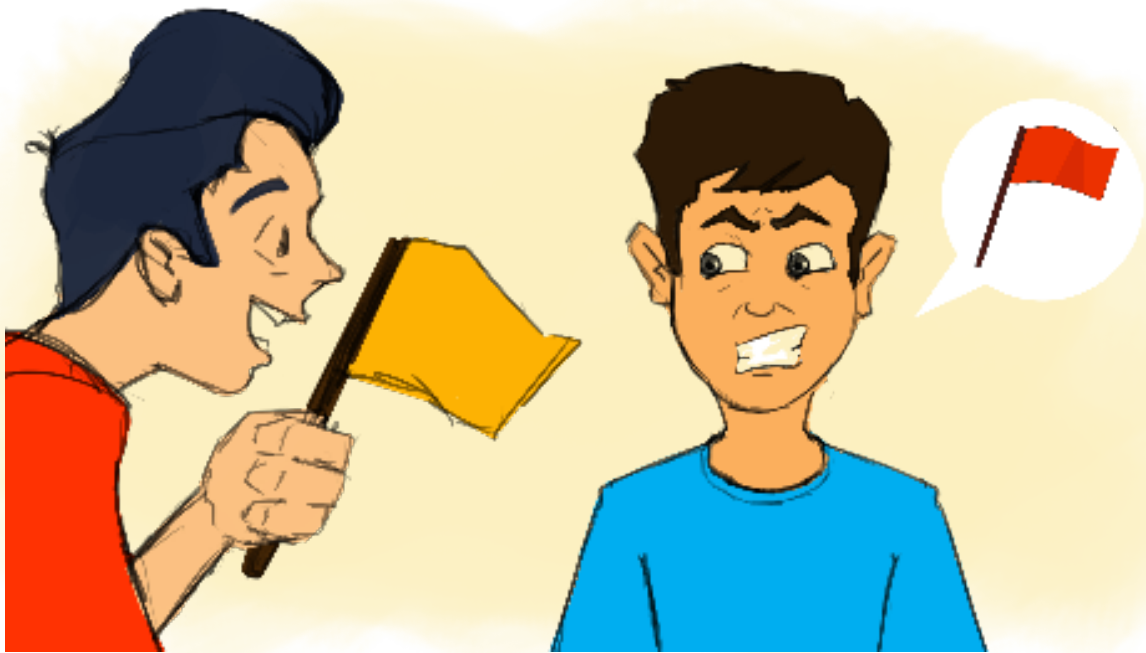


Ben's *heresy* astounds his religious friends.

Dev had an idea to reduce the city's traffic but Gaurav was skeptical about the **heuristic** process involved..

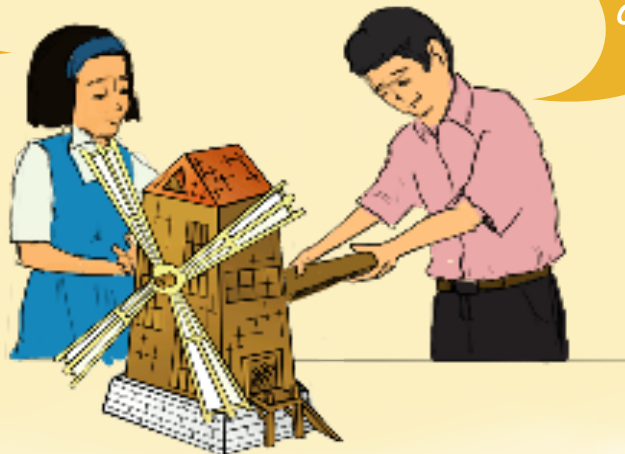
Iteration
