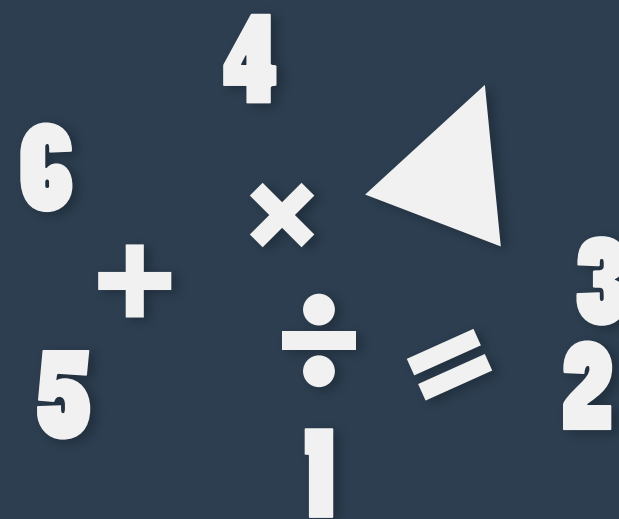

A very harsh and strong piercing use of words against the other.

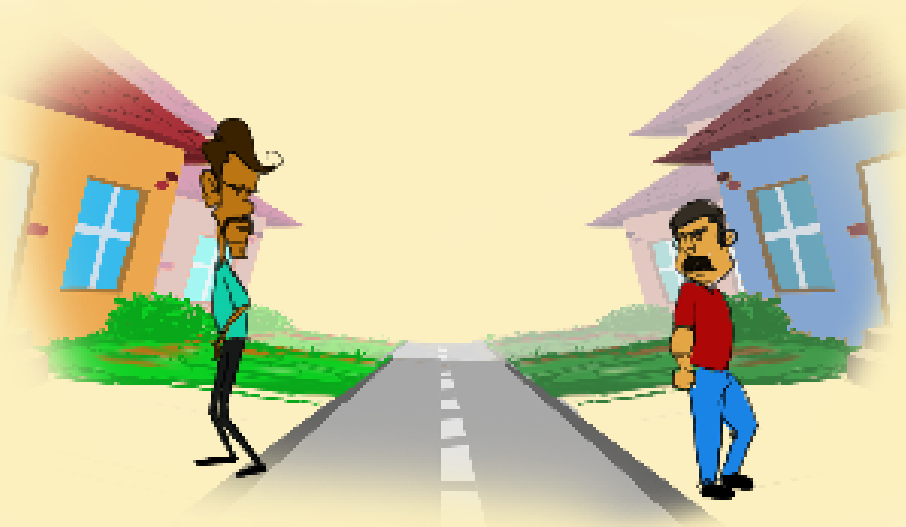


Both Gaurav and Hassan used **acrimonious** language towards each other.

Pugnacious

(Adjective)

Aggrandize (verb)

To make something appear greater.
