Ice-cream's made from milk though. Isn't milk good?



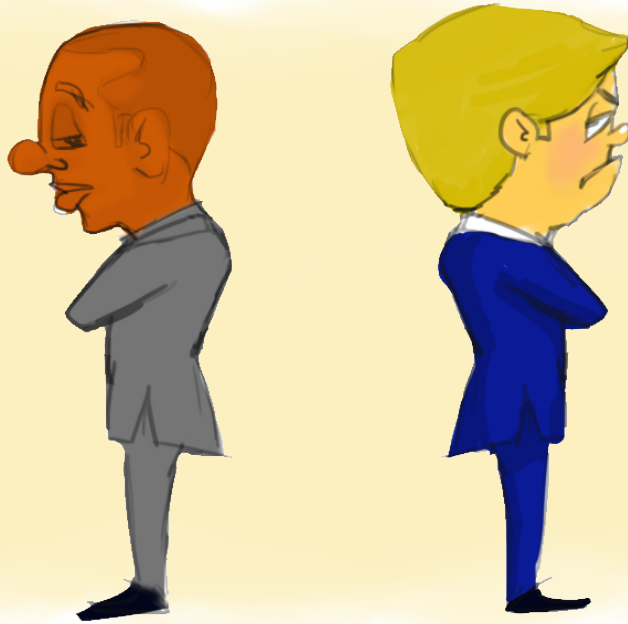
Nice try, Ben.

To bring two warring sides back together.

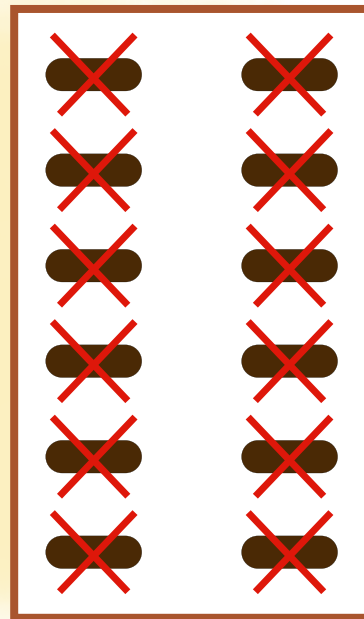


It is difficult to bring Amir and Ben to some sort of a **rapprochement**.

To use evidence and prove false.

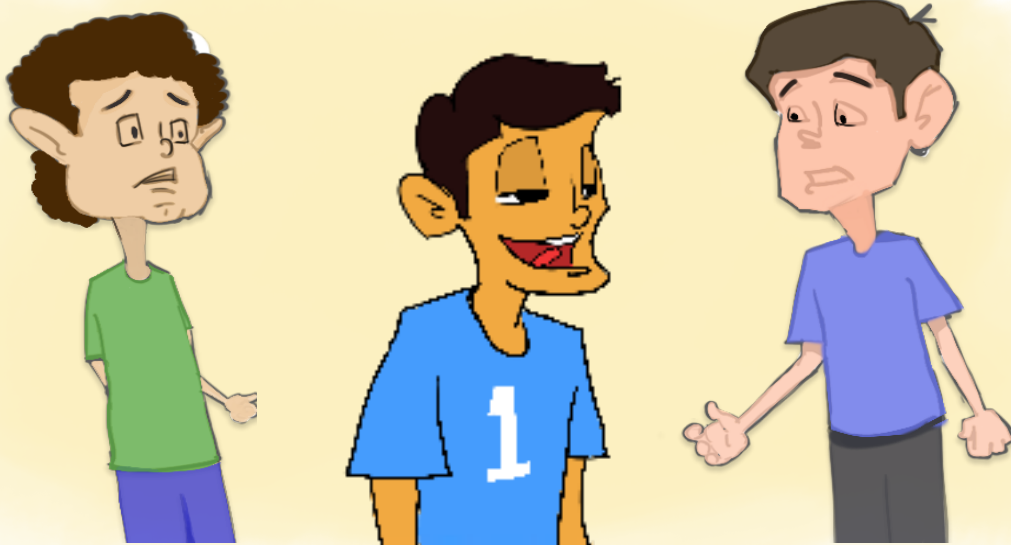


Hassan *refutes* his opponent's arguments with logic.

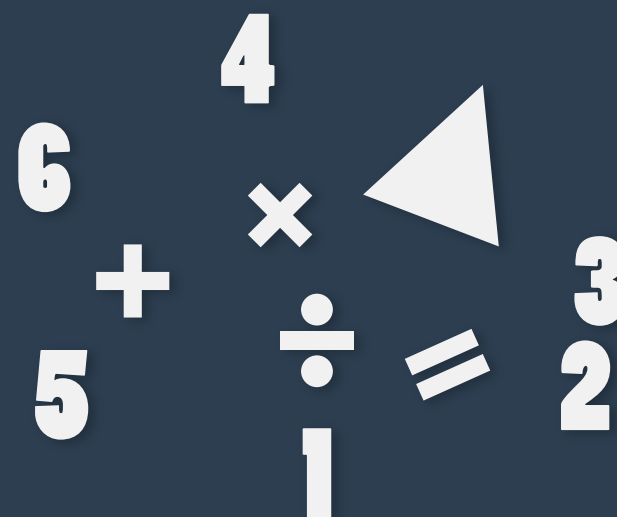

Impatient; fidgety.

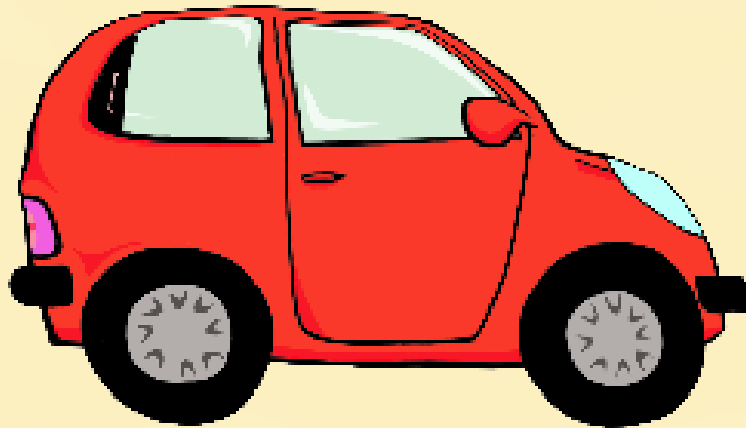


Disha was **restive** as her exams approached.

Salient

(Adjective)

most noticeable or important.

Circumscribe

(Verb)

Lay down restrictions.
